

## SELECTION CRITERIA FOR CHAIRMAN'S CUP TEAM 2018

### UNIVERSAL TRENCH

- a.) The trial period will commence at the SA Grand on 26 April 2018 and run up to October 2018.
- b.) All 100 x raw target scores of 80/100 or better shot by a trialist during the trial period at the shoots mentioned in c) below, will be recorded as a percentage of high gun, i.e. by dividing the score shot by the trialist with the high gun score for the specific round of 100 x targets shot and officially recorded by the organisers of the shoot, multiplied by 100.
- c.) All 100 x raw target scores of 80/100 or better shot by a trialist at the following shoots during the trial period shall be considered for qualification:
- SA Grand at Centurion Gun Club in April 2018 – the first 200 championship targets shot (i.e. the first 2 x 100 targets shot excluding any third round shot as a national trial only) - possible 2 x 100 target scores;
  - All local VGC UT Club 100 shoots recorded as a WC Trial event on the VGC 2018 Shoot Calendar, starting in July 2018 and ending at the last UT Club 100 shoot in October 2018 - possible 4 x 100 target scores; and
  - All 100 x target scores shot at the Free State (August 2018), Northern Cape (September 2018) and Western Cape (October 2018) Provincial Standard Championships - possible 6 x 100 target scores.

In total: possible 12 x 100 target scores

- d.) The highest 4 x 100 target scores (being a raw target scores of 80/100 or better and recorded as a percentage of high gun and rounded off to two decimal places) **each** equal to or better than the minimum qualifying score recorded in g.) below and of which a minimum of 2 scores must have been shot and recorded at Valley Gun Club, shall be used for automatic qualification as envisaged in f) below.
- e.) For the avoidance of doubt, all scores recorded by a trialist at the VGC UT Club 100 shoots and Western Cape Provincial Standard Championship (in total a possible 6 x 100 target scores), shall be regarded as scores having been shot and recorded at Valley Gun Club.

- f.) The top 3 shooters with the highest score (by adding up the 4 highest minimum qualifying scores recorded as a percentage of high gun by each trialist as calculated and envisaged in d.) above and dividing it by 4, rounded off to two decimal places), will automatically be selected for the WC Chairman's Cup Team.
- g.) The minimum qualifying score of **each** of the 4 highest scores eligible for automatic qualification as envisaged in d.) and f.) above, shall be **93% of high gun**.
- h.) In the event of tied scores for automatic qualification (i.e. for the remaining automatic place(s) in the team), a shoot-off will take place. The shoot-off will be over 100 targets at Valley Gun Club and will take place as soon as possible after the last trial event in October 2018. In the event that scores remain tied after the 100 x target shoot-off, a single barrel sudden-death will be shot with the first zero eliminating the trialist after each trialist has shot the same number of targets.
- i.) In the event that any one or all of the top 3 shooters fail to obtain the minimum qualifying score as reflected in g.) above, then team selection in respect of the remaining non automatic qualifying place(s) per discipline on the team, shall be at the discretion of the WC Selection Committee, provided that the person(s) so selected, shall be a registered CTSASA member and Western Cape participant in the particular discipline that has shown recent good form in Club- and Provincial competitions.
- j.) The WC Selection Committee shall comprise of the WC Chairman plus the delegate from each of the 4 disciplines (namely trap, skeet, sporting & trench) as nominated at the AGM of WCCTA. In total 5 persons shall therefore form the Selection Committee. In instances where a Selection Committee decision is required, a simple majority will reflect the decision of the Selection Committee. The decision of the Selection Committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding team selection.
